1. Delivery and removal of entries, ribbons and awards will be in accordance with the Calendar of Events and Delivery Time for Exhibits shown in this book.
2. Any amateur flower grower or gardener in Otero County may exhibit, whether a member of a garden club or not.
3. **Entries should be carefully groomed and free of dust, soil, insects and discolored leaves. No leaf shine. Each specimen must be trimmed and ready to place in container.**
4. All exhibits will be classified and judged against their own name, color and size, even though not listed on the schedule.
5. If possible, all specimens should be correctly named and labeled.
6. All entries must be checked with the Classification and Entry Committees.
7. The decision of the judges is final.
8. The OCFA not the Flower Show Committee will be responsible for damage to exhibits, or for exhibits not removed by the exhibitor.
9. Any container larger than 18" or weigh more than 20 pounds must be handled and placed by the exhibitor.
10. Previous blue ribbon entries may not be entered in subsequent shows with the same planter in the same category.
