1. Competition is open to anyone in Otero County.
2. Only one entry per division is allowed.
3. Only products grown or hand-made by the exhibitors may be displayed.
4. Varieties must be labeled in all divisions/subdivisions and ribbons will be awarded for the best three (3) entries for any one variety or division/subdivision.
5. Entries will be delivered to the Fairgrounds and all entries, ribbons and awards removed in accordance with the Calendar of Events and Delivery Times for Exhibits shown on the Otero County Fair website.
6. Entries to be judged against their own variety, color and size.
7. The Grand Champion exhibitor will be awarded a Rosette. **Divisions 1 through 6 will be considered in awarding the Grand Champion.**
8. The Junior Grand Champion will also be presented a Rosette. **Divisions 1 through 6 will be considered in awarding the Junior Grand Champion.**
9. Judges decisions are final.
