RV RULES & APPLICATION

Water & Electric Fee: \$70

Dry Camping: No Charge

Application entry opens: July 1, 2024

Application entry deadline: July 31, 2024

1. A signed copy of the rules for the RV area and RV information sheet must be on file with the Otero County Fair Association (OCFA) office in order for you to be allowed access to the grounds.
2. Dry camping will be designated to the Rodeo Arena parking lot. Exhibitor parking will be designated inside the gates with water and electric hook up, upon availability.
3. Application entries will open July 1st with a deadline of July 31st. There will be no late entries unless spots are not filled.
4. **RV spots placement will be given in the following order:**
 - a. Medical accommodations (such as CPAP machines and oxygen concentrators) then,
 - b. in order of farthest physical address from the fairgrounds
5. Once you have been assigned a spot, you will be invoiced for the \$70 water and electric fee. This fee must be paid by September 1st to prevent losing your spot.
6. The OCFA will maintain a waiting list for those unable to secure a camping spot or who turn in a late application. The spaces that become available will be assigned to the person on the waiting list with the physical address farthest from the fairgrounds until the list is exhausted. Waiting lists do not roll over and a new list is created each year.
7. The OCFA has the right to assign campers to any spot or location as needed.
8. RV spots cannot be resold or used by anyone other than those listed on the application.
9. RV spot tenants who become unruly or belligerent with the OCFA or Junior Livestock Committee will be permanently evicted from the fairgrounds.
10. The OCFA reserves the right to cancel an RV spot contract at any time and to refuse or reject any applications for camping and will not be held responsible for accidents of any sort.
11. An adult must accompany each campsite.
